

Instructions for the children For Sunday 5th April 2020

In advance of Palm Sunday – The procession. Lets get ready to act this out.

First make a cloak, either from material, your dressing up box or a big coat around your shoulders.

Secondly, make your palm fronds, Google – “palm fronds for palm Sunday” this shows you how to make many types. Make them, colour in your drawings of palm leaves and prepare for a triumphant procession up to Jerusalem.

Read Matthew 21 v 1 to 11.

Get all this ready to act out the events.

Then on Sunday, at the right time on the “order of service” (parents will prompt you), start by very excitedly lining the route of the procession. Everyone is just very very excited.

Then you see the procession approach. A man riding on a donkey?????

You throw down your cloaks and some of your palm leaves on to the floor in front of this man on a donkey. You vigorously wave the palm leaves you didn't throw on the floor in awe of the man!!!!

Everybody cries' out and are shouting and jumping up and down excitedly!

'Hosanna'

'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!'

'Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!'

'Hosanna in the highest heaven!'

Mark 11: 8-10
