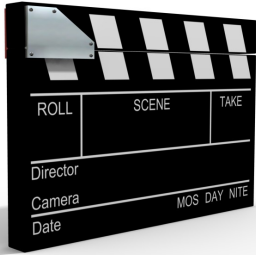


Clapperboard Workshops 2018

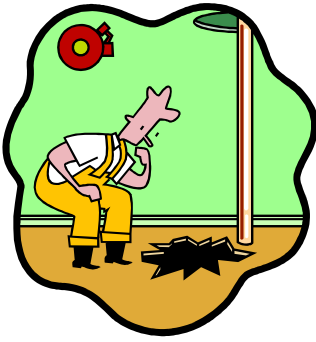

In the unfortunate event of an accident whilst your child attends the Workshop we shall:

1. Attend to the child accordingly by a member of the project who has a certified emergency First Aid Certificate.
2. Administer the incident appropriately to the injury.
3. If the child requires medical attention we shall proceed to the nearest Medical Centre or Hospital.
4. We shall contact you as soon as possible.

In Loco Parentis

It is sometimes assumed that people who look after children have “loco parentis” (in place of the parents) authority. However in law, a parent cannot surrender or transfer parental responsibility (this means all rights, duties, powers responsibilities and authority which by law a parent has in relation to a child and his/her property).

This can only be done through legal agreements relating to guardianship, and where a court has made a custody care order.

The consent form which parents are asked to sign for certain activities may give the workers authority to take a child away, but cannot act as a legal agreement transferring parental responsibility. It also does not give staff any authority to consent to any medical treatment.

Monitoring: *All information provided will be kept confidential. This information is for the purpose of monitoring and fundraising only and in no way affects participation of a child in club. Victoria Park Baptist Church is committed to operating Equal opportunities policy in all its projects.*

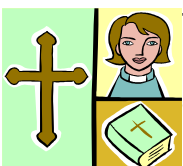
