### Please Note:

If, in the unfortunate event of an accident whilst your child attends the Craft Morning, we shall:

- Attend to your child accordingly with a member of the project who has a certified emergency First Aid Certificate.
- Administer to the incident appropriately to the injury.
- If the child requires medical attention, we shall proceed to the nearest Medical Centre or Hospital.
- We shall contact you as soon as possible.

### *In Loco Parentis*

*It is sometimes assumed that people who look after children have “loco parentis” (in place of the parents) authority. However, in law, a parent cannot surrender or transfer parental responsibility (this means all rights, duties, powers responsibilities and authority which by law a parent has in relation to a child and his/her property).*

*This can only be done through legal agreements relating to guardianship, and where a court has made a custody care order.*

*The consent form which parents are asked to sign for certain activities may give the workers authority to take a child away, but cannot act as a legal agreement transferring parental responsibility. It also does not give staff any authority to consent to any medical treatment.*
